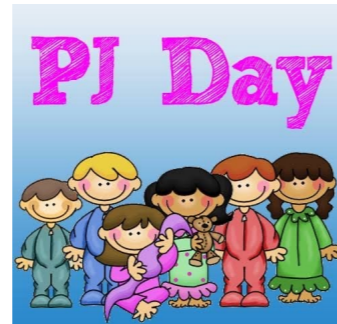


## Crazy Hair and Pyjama Day
