Remembrance day

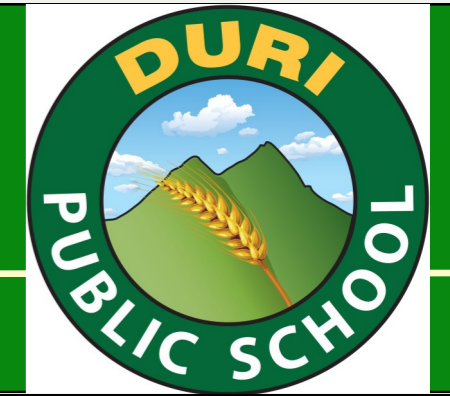
Students commemorated Remembrance Day last Thursday. Rylee and Xavier read 'For the Fallen' and 'In Flanders Field'.
