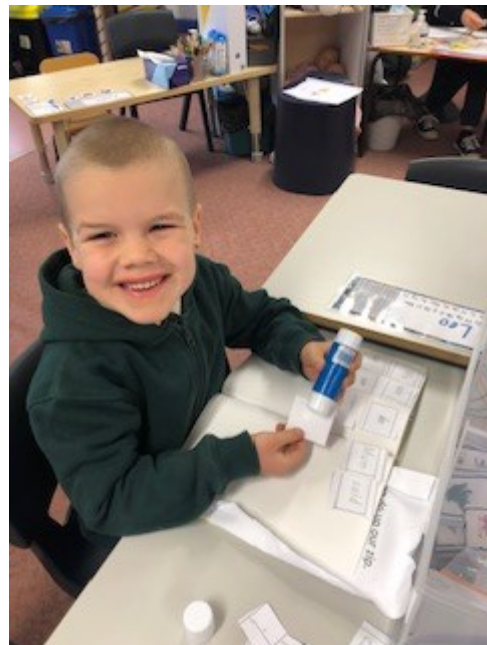


## Junior Classroom

During our Gamilaraay lessons Shellie showed us dhinawan (emu) eggs and feathers. She also told us stories about the dhinawan.



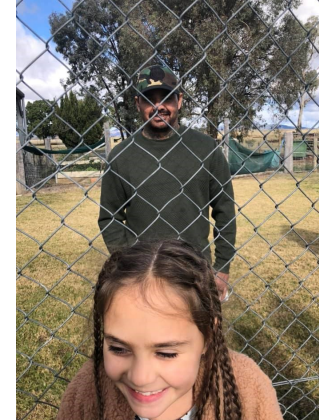
