## GOLD COAST/ BRISBANE Excursion

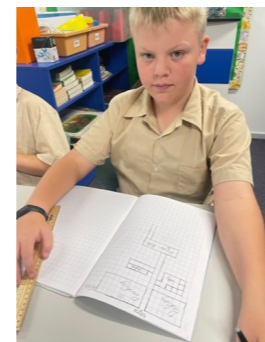
