Bus Behaviour

Towards the end of last term we had some extremely unsafe behaviour on the town bus. There were instances of students out of their seats, wrestling, throwing objects and yelling. Mr Mason was forced to pull over at one point as students were acting in an unsafe manner. We have introduced a bus behaviour warning card. If your child is issued one of these and the unsafe behaviour continues they will not be permitted to travel on the bus for one week (5 school days).
